CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG ADULTS

Wheels on Water (WOW) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Instructors or committee members.

As a sailing member of WOW you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must respect those who are sailing with them and obey any instructions given to them by the Instructors when on or off the water.
- All members must respect others' opinions.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for arriving at the Mount Batten Centre for sailing sessions; inform the centre by phone if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable clothing for sailing as stated by the Mount Batten Centre Code of Conduct.
- When on the pontoon or water, buoyancy aids must be worn at all times.
- Members must pay any session fees on the day unless a prior arrangement has been agreed.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or non-prescribed drugs of any kind during the sessions.
- Members are to use correct and proper language at all times.
